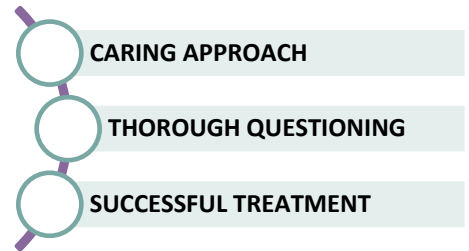
Family Nurse Practitioner
